Call To Order/Roll Call

Closed Session

Recommendation on Expulsion

Considering the information presented at the discipline hearing, it was recommended that a Lombard Middle School Student (Case #13-08), be expelled for the remainder of the 2012-2013 school year and expelled for the 2013-2014 school year. Student may return in August 2013 on principal's probation provided completion and documentation of successful assessment and treatment in an approved certified counseling program specializing in anger management and conflict resolution is submitted to Lombard Middle School by August 1, 2013. In addition, student must participate in the APEX program at Galesburg High School North for one hour per day beginning immediately and APEX program during Lombard Middle School summer school. Student must complete a minimum of three APEX courses determined by the principal with a C or better in each course, which must be completed by August 1, 2013. If student does not complete the APEX courses with the appropriate grade, the student will remain out of school until January 2014. All documentation must be provided to Lombard Middle School by August 1, 2013.

Student may return to Galesburg High School North beginning Term 1 of the 2013-2014 school year provided documentation of successful assessment and subsequent treatment by a certified professional counseling provider is submitted to Galesburg High School North by August 1, 2013. It was moved by Member Colclasure and seconded by Member Panther that the Board of Education approve the above recommendation as stated.
