Student may enroll on probation at the Knox County Academy or District #205 Alternative School beginning Term 3 of the 2008-2009 school year provided documentation of assessment and subsequent treatment by certified professional counseling provider is provided to Galesburg High School by December 15, 2008. Credit recovery will be available as approved by building principal.
